The Community Council are still in the process of taking forward a Category Asset Transfer of Cornelly Community Centre from Bridgend County Borough Council. However, as reported in the August 2018 Newsletter, prior to the transfer, replacement of the roof needs to be completed. Arrangements are now in place for a new roof to be fitted, with work scheduled to commence on 25th March 2019. There will be no disruption to use of the Centre during the construction work, all activities will continue as normal. Mr Goff has also donated £220, which he raised by organising a community carol singing event on Christmas Eve, toward the next defibrillator to be installed, which will be in South Cornelly.
